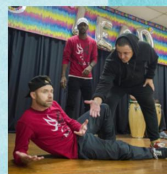

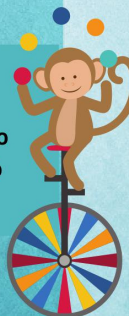

EMILY WEBB



Emily Webb is the newest employee at the Jackson Parish Library, having only started in August of last year. Working in a library has been her dream job for as long as she can remember. She is the Bookmobile and Outreach Specialist working alongside Amber Paggett. Previously, she worked at Louisiana Tech University as an Administrative Coordinator in the post office. She has worked off and on in administrative positions since graduating from Louisiana Tech University in 2008.

Her job duties at the library include: driving the bookmobile, taking books to outreach patrons, and gathering books for teachers during Covid since children aren't allowed to come on board. Although she started at a time when outings have been limited, she looks forward to the days when the children will be able to come onto the bookmobile and browse through the books. She also awaits the days when they will be able to visit a few minutes with the outreach patrons to help curb some of their loneliness. Working at the library has been a joy for her, even for the short time that she's been here.

Emily lived in Ruston, LA up until she was about 8 years old. After that, her family built a home in the backwoods of Clay, LA, just inside Jackson Parish. She lived there up until 2013, when her husband decided to move the family to Colorado for him to attend Bible college. Her family spent almost 6 years there in the colder climate.
